



## Brunswick Station: From Vacant Lot to Multi-Million Dollar Hub

Brunswick, Maine, November 28, 2022: In the largest reported transaction in Brunswick in more than five years, JHR Development sold its portfolio of five buildings and associated parking lots at Brunswick Station to WFF Brunswick for \$18 million. The transaction was arranged on behalf of the seller by Drew Sigfridson, SIOR of The Boulos Company. The properties comprise retail, office, and medical office space, as well as two residential buildings.

JHR developed the Brunswick Station complex 13 years ago on what was then a vacant brownfield lot. It has since grown into a commercial, residential, and transportation hub, connecting the neighborhood around Bowdoin College with Maine Street's shops and businesses, while offering train service to Portland and Boston. The central location, with its strong, mixed-use tenant base appealed to the buyer, who has a background managing residential and commercial assets. They will retain Boulos Asset Management to manage the property for a seamless transition.
