Brunswick, Maine, November 21, 2022: Laura Marston is leasing 163 Pleasant Street to open a new <u>GoGo Refill</u>. The 1,100± SF building is the second location for Marston's low-waste, plastic-free retail business. Cameron Foster of The Boulos Company handled the transaction on behalf of the landlord, Holland Low, who was seeking a low-impact tenant. Built in 1990, the building is getting a fresh facelift before the planned opening on December 1.

Marston is on a mission to help people reduce their plastic waste. GoGo Refill offers "durable, delightfully effective products and bulk home essentials consciously curated to lessen the need for harmful single use plastics." Products are priced per ounce, so customers can buy what they need, filling their own clean containers or borrowing from the shop's "container library."

"We've had a dedicated group of customers who travel from the Brunswick area to our South Portland store ever since we opened in 2019," said Laura Marston. "We are really excited to bring GoGo's low-waste resources and plastic-free living closer to them, and to meet all the great people in this area. We've been able to make a big impact with our South Portland store and we're looking forward to spreading the low-waste, plastic-free message in another community."

<u>GoGo Refill</u> provides some sobering statics: In the U.S. alone, 38 billion plastic bottles get thrown away annually, which amounts to 2.2 million tons of plastic going into landfills. And sadly, only 5–6% of plastic is recycled globally. The good news is, collective individual actions can make a difference. Since opening, GoGo Refill has saved over 120,000 plastic packages.
